

The following cleaning codes apply to the textile only. Special finishes, flame resistant treatments or moisture barriers added to the product may change the textile's cleaning code.

Always pre-test first in an inconspicuous area! Do not saturate the textile as the upholstery filling materials may damage.

- W**
- Clean with water-based shampoo or foam upholstery cleaner. Spot clean with the foam of a water-based cleaning agent such as a mild detergent or commercial upholstery shampoo. Use sparingly and avoid overwetting. Finish with water to remove the cleaning agent.
 - Do not saturate
 - Do not use solvents to spot clean
 - Pile fabrics may require brushing to restore appearance
 - Cushion covers should not be removed and laundered
- S**
- Frequent vacuuming or light brushing to remove dust and grime is recommended. Be careful not to create any abrasions or blemishes. Follow the instructions carefully when using a solvent or dry cleaning product. Clean only in a well-ventilated area. Clean with a dry cleaning solvent, which should be evenly dispersed and immediately absorbed/vacuumed. Do not apply large amounts of solvent that could penetrate the fabric down to the foam/padding as the solvent may damage or dissolve the filling.
 - Do not saturate
 - Do not use water
 - Pile fabrics may require brushing to restore appearance
 - Cushion covers should not be removed and laundered
- WS**
- Frequent vacuuming or light brushing to remove dust and grime is recommended. Spot clean with a mild solvent, upholstery shampoo or foam from a mild detergent. Always pre-test first in a small inconspicuous area before proceeding. Professional cleaning may be required when the piece is excessively soiled.
 - Do not saturate with liquid
 - Pile fabrics may require brushing to restore appearance
 - Cushion covers should not be removed and laundered

*In the W code, this does not include "hot extraction" method. Crypton does recommend this method for cleaning.
